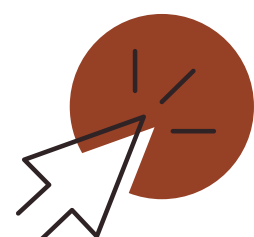
TRAINING COURSE

Between the 11-18th September 2020 a Training Course will be held in Spain.

It has been designed to comply with one of the goals of the project:

To make adults and adult workers acquire new entrepreneurial skills based on sustainability through the new methodologies and tools offered during this Training Course, in order to promote entrepreneurship education and social entrepreneurship among young people.

The methodology of the course will be a combination between theoretical participative activities and the analysis of real case studies, in which the participants will be able to visit local initiatives of entrepreneurship in rural areas of Cantabria while they will attend different training sessions about sustainability, entrepreneurship and innovative methods of project design.



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
